Loan Policy

Any person wishing to borrow library materials must register with the library by name and permanent address. All new patrons must show ID/proof of permanent address. College students must additionally provide proof of local residence. Changes in address and phone number must be reported to the library.

Books, magazines (excepting the current issue), video collections (such as TV seasons), and audiobooks may be borrowed for three weeks, and video materials may be borrowed for 1 week. All materials may be renewed either by the patron or by system auto-renewal unless they are designated "new" or are on reserve for another patron.

Overdue charges

Overdue materials fines are charged per day when the library is open. The library does not charge fines for days the library is closed.

Fines are charged as follows:

Video materials - \$1.00 a day

All other materials - \$.10 a day

Maximum fines charged per item - \$5.00

Patron accounts with fines and/or lost item fees totaling \$5.00 or more will be suspended until fine/fee totals are \$4.99 or less. If a patron experiences hardship in paying their fines/fees or feels that fines/fees have been levied unfairly, they may address the situation with the library director.
