The Mount Morris Library will seek to provide books and other library resources for the interest, information, and enlightenment of all people of the community. Materials will not be excluded because of the origin, or views of those contributing to their creation. It will endeavor to provide information representing all points of view on current and historical issues. Material will not be banned simply because it conflicts with the point of view of the reader.

The Mount Morris Library recognizes that no one should be denied to use the library because of origin, age, background, or views.

The Mount Morris Library will make the space available to the community, regardless of the beliefs or affiliations of individuals or groups requesting their use.
